## **NAL COVID-19 Refresher Training**

## All NAL Team Members:

Due to the increased number of coronavirus cases in our facilities and communities, we wanted to remind everyone of our standard NAL COVID-19 Playbook guidelines to prevent the spread of the virus. Please review and follow these protocols:

- Make sure you are taking your temperature as well as your family members' temperatures daily. NAL Team Members must complete their daily health check at <a href="https://healthcheck.nal.com/">https://healthcheck.nal.com/</a> prior to reporting for work. Please answer the questions truthfully and follow all directions as given. If you are sick, stay home and contact your local Human Resources Department.
- Everyone must wear an NAL issued or approved mask upon entry to any NAL facility.
   The mask should be worn at all times except while seated behind barriers in the break room to eat.
- Every effort will be made to provide social distancing when possible. The standard distance is defined as six feet or more. Please observe yellow markings throughout all facilities that help designate proper social distancing.
- Sanitation is everyone's responsibility. Work stations or cells should be wiped down at
  the beginning and end of one's rotation, shift or during downtime. Equipment or
  machinery should be wiped down after use. In all circumstances, utilize the cleaning
  solutions and equipment provided by NAL.
- Only essential visitors supporting NAL manufacturing will be allowed in our facilities to provide equipment repairs, supply deliveries, shipping, etc. These individuals must also be health screened prior to their admittance and must wear a mask at all times.
- NAL travel is limited to support the essential functions of our business so please review those guidelines in the playbook.
